He was the Principal of a dental practice located in Adelaide, where he delivered dental care based on the philosophy of Minimal Intervention over a period of 18 years. Over the years, he has lectured in more than 34 countries and 60 universities and was instrumental in establishing the "Minimal Intervention 2020" projects in Adelaide and other dental schools throughout South East Asia. In 2009, he was invited to the University of Queensland as Professor and Chair of General Dental Practice. At present, his main focus in research, revolves around the clinical management of caries in the elderly and medically compromised patients and the interactions between the glass-ionomers and the oral environment.
